

**KEENE TOWNSHIP**  
**ORDINANCE ADOPTION NOTICE**

On May 14, 2019, the Keene Township Board adopted a Medical Marihuana Facilities Ordinance. There are definitions that match the State descriptions. Two growing facilities will be allowed of Class A up to 500 plants. No other permits will be given such as a provision center, safety compliance center, processor or secured transporter. A permit may be issued by the Township Board if the grower obtains a State license and follows all the regulations. The Zoning Ordinance will be amended to choose which zoning districts will allow a grower facility. An application section describes the forms and fees. The application review and approval section will describe the process for an approval. A permit approval time will correspond to the State license and a renewal process is described along with a renewal fee. There is a violation section for offenses and fines. This ordinance does not apply to a lawful registered qualifying caregiver or patient. Noncompliance with the State Acts, zoning or other applicable ordinances may result in a permit revocation according to that section's described process.
